The receipt must be signed by the charity, and must be in your hands no later than the filing date of your return. With the exception of publicly traded securities, most donations over \$5,000 require a written appraisal.

**Author's Comment:** The price ranges shown on this page represent a compilation based on valuation guides published by various charitable organizations. The list is not to be considered authoritative guidance for purposes of establishing the fair market value of donated property.

**Note:** No deduction is allowed for a charitable contribution of clothing or household items unless the clothing or household item is in good used condition or better. The IRS is authorized by regulation to deny a deduction for any contribution of clothing or a household item that has minimal monetary value, such as used socks and undergarments.

**Planning Tip:** Most cell phones today can take pictures. Take a picture of all items donated. Keep the electronic pictures for proof the items were in good or better condition at the time they were donated.

## Recordkeeping Rules for Charitable Contributions (page 4-19)

To help substantiate a deduction for the fair market value of used items donated to charity, make a list of each item donated on a separate sheet of paper along with the following information.

- Name and address of charity.
- Date items were donated to the charity.
- Description of each item donated.
- Fair market value of each item at the time they were donated (see the list on this page).
- Date each donated item was originally purchased or acquired.
- Cost or other basis of each item donated.



## Limitations on Donation of Property Which Has Increased In Value

Type of Property	Deduction Limited To
<b>Ordinary income property:</b> inventory, donor's creative work, and capital assets held less than one year.	FMV less amount of ordinary income or short-term capital gain amount if property had been sold.
<b>Capital gain property:</b> stocks, bonds, jewelry, coin or stamp collections, and cars and furniture used for personal purposes.	FMV of property.*

\* For certain types of contributions, this may be limited. See *Reductions to FMV*, page 4-16, for more information.
